The Canandaigua Lake Chamber Music Festival will take us on a "guided tour" of one of Mozart's greatest gems, the celebrated quartet for oboe and strings. The audience will have the opportunity to coach the musicians on their performance and to compose musical examples based on Mozart's original.
