The objective is to use word and image clues to guess the authors, titles, and places associated with ten works of fiction, all set in New York State. Then, show off your geography skills by plotting the places on a New York State map. Reading the books earns extra credit. Deadline for entries is August 14 at 5pm. ## Wood Receives Thompson Grant

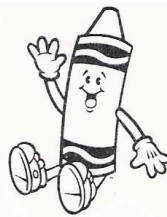
